### At the August Town Council meeting:

Council members heard an update on the Asheville Regional Airport from Lew Bleiweis, Executive Director. Improvements are underway to improve the service to the airport and a new parking garage will be coming in the near future. Construction on the parking deck is estimated to take about 1 year. At present four carriers are servicing this airport.

Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager, reported on the work of the New Fletcher Library Partners that have been addressing the need for a new library facility to replace the current location. Members of the committee have been researching what other counties are doing in financing and operating branches of public libraries located within limits of municipalities located within their counties.



Area schools are now in session, and drivers are reminded to use extra care in school zones and travel the appropriate speed limits! Town of Fletcher property tax bills have been mailed. The Town receives its tax information from Henderson County Assessor's office and as soon as the data is received, our Tax office processes and mails the bills. The Tax lien attaches to the property legally on January 1 of the taxing year, but because the tax rate is determined by the Town Council at the end of June, bills can not be sent until late summer. The official due date is September 1, and taxes may be paid any time up to the delinquency date without penalty. The delinquency date for 2016 taxes will be January 6, 2017. At that time, all unpaid taxes will become delinquent and interest charges will begin to accrue and possible enforced collection procedures may begin.

Partial payments are accepted for taxes during the time of receipt of tax notices and the date of delinquency, but all taxes must be paid by the date of delinquency. Taxing governments in North Carolina are not legally obligated to furnish property owners a tax notice! It is the responsibility of the citizen to know that they owe taxes in that jurisdiction—just as you know that you are responsible for state and federal income taxes. Our information, such as mailing addresses and listed names, is received from Henderson County and we try to get notices to the correct place, but the tax obligation still exists even if the taxpayer does not receive a notice.

#### TRASH TALK

Please follow the guidelines for trash disposal using the roll-out cans! All trash **must be bagged** within the roll-out trash receptacle! This is to prevent trash from blowing out when the can is lifted into



the truck. If Public Works employees discover the contents are not bagged, they will tag the can and not pick up the contents! **Do not leave bags of trash outside of the rolling carts or leave the carts in the roadway.** Public Works employees have encountered a continuing problem with residents leaving loose trash or additional bags or boxes of trash placed beside the rolling trash cans.

Leaves will begin to fall soon. Bagged leaf pick up will begin for the Town on Monday, October 3rd.

The Town **does not** pickup televisions, computer components or grills. These items are not allowed in landfills in North Carolina and must be disposed of at the Henderson County Convenience Center on Stoney Mountain Road. Some electronics retailers offer in-store drop-off programs for electronics of all kinds, from computers to fax machines. Some offer recycling kiosks for items such as ink and toner cartridges, rechargeable batteries, cords, and cables, and will accept most electronic gear at the customer service counters.

Brush pickup starts on Mondays of every week, unless that day is a holiday. Then it will start on Tuesday of those weeks. You do need to call in a work order before Mondays to 687-3985 or 654-9208. You can leave your request for brush pickup and your address on the voicemail 24 hours a day.

If you have any questions about the services offered by Public Works, please call 654-9208 and leave a message along with your telephone number. Someone will return your call.

Curbside Management has a new driver in Fletcher! They ask that you have bins out by the required 7 a.m. And if your recycling is not picked up on the scheduled day, please call 252-2532.


