

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 13 FOR THE PROPOSED WIDENING OF OLD AIRPORT ROAD (S.R. 1547) BETWEEN HENDERSONVILLE ROAD (U.S. 25) AND CANE CREEK ROAD (S.R. 1545) IN FLETCHER, HENDERSON COUNTY

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold an informal public meeting regarding the proposed widening of Old Airport Road (S.R. 1547) between Hendersonville Road (U.S. 25) and Cane Creek Road (S.R. 1545) in Fletcher.

The purpose of this project is to improve safety and traffic flow on Old Airport Road by adding a painted or planted median and intersection improvements.

The public meeting will take place on Tuesday, **September 13, 2016**, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Fletcher Town Hall located at 300 Old Cane Creek Road in Fletcher. No formal presentation will be made.

NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed project. Interested citizens may attend at any time. Project Maps will be available for viewing. Citizens will also have the opportunity to submit written comments and questions. All comments must be received no later than September 27, 2016.
