

Determining your Recycling Collection Day

Recyclables are collected **every other week on your regular scheduled trash day** by Curbside Recycling, LLC. (Curbie). You may call Fletcher Town Hall to determine your recycling week. We ask that you prepare the recyclables following the guidelines in this brochure and place them in recycling bins. Please have them **curbside by 7:00 am** on your pickup day.

Town of Fletcher Recycles

Make recycling as easy as 1, 2, 3!

First, decide on a storage area. The kitchen, where most household refuse originates, is an ideal place for a home recycling center. Put it in a place where you'll remember to use it such as under the sink or in a closet or pantry. A location in the garage or near a back door can also be used for storage.

Second, take every opportunity to fill your recycling bins with properly prepared recyclable materials. You may pick up recycling bins at Fletcher Town Hall. Place all your recyclable material into the bins.

Third, place your recycling bins at the curb by 7 a.m. on your regularly scheduled, weekly collection day. Flatten cardboard boxes and place underneath your bins.

- Glass Bottles and Jars (Brown, Green and Clear)

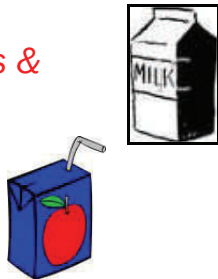


- Aluminum Pie Tins & Food Trays

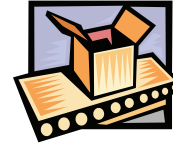

- Corrugated Cardboard (please flatten)

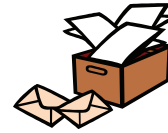
