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News from the July Town Council Meeting

August 2020

The meeting was held in the Council Chambers with social distancing guidelines and mass gathering recommendations being followed.

- The Town Council took action on the following matters from the Consent Agenda:
 - Cynthia Broome, Tax Collector, was reappointed and charged with collecting 2020-2021 property taxes for the Town of Fletcher.
 - The bond from Windsor Built Homes, for the remaining sidewalks and street trees in Phase 1 of Sycamore Cottages, was released.
 - Property tax releases from the Henderson County Tax Office were approved.
 - The year-end Tax Collector's report for fiscal year 2019-2020 was approved.
- A public hearing was held to consider CD application #2020-02 from Graycliff Capital for a 198 unit multifamily residential development proposed for Rutledge Road. The request sought to conditionally zone the property R-3, from R-2, which would allow a multi-family development of 7.5 units per acre. Following a presentation by the developers, and after receiving considerable public input, the Town Council voted unanimously to deny the application and leave the current zoning in place.
- Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager, provided an update on discussions with Carolina Truffieres regarding provisions of a potential lease agreement on a portion of Town property across from Meritor. He indicated that Carolina Truffieres was comfortable with all provisions of the agreement with the exception of not having the option to purchase the property at the end of the ten year lease period. They indicated that due to the investment they would have to make in the property over this period of time, it would be problematic for them to potentially lose the property at the end of the lease period. Council indicated they would be interested in entertaining a potential extension of the lease, at the end of that period, but not an option to purchase the property. Mr. Biberdorf will share this with Carolina Truffieres, but noted that the non-purchase option may be a sticking point for further lease discussions.
- Mark Biberdorf provided an update on the following matters:
 - Town Center Project The first part of our RFP process closed on 6/15/20. We received 2 letters of interest and have communicated with other interested parties since then. Full proposal submissions are due by 9/30/20. Also, the deed issue with the Kevin Walker property has now been satisfied so we should close on that property soon.
 - Shred Event Our shred and pill drop event has been rescheduled for 9/12/20.
 - COVID-19 A face covering policy is now in effect for Town staff. If unable to maintain social distancing in the normal course of their duties, including while in vehicles, employees must wear a face covering. Also, our summer concerts have been rescheduled and will we have a drive-in movie in the Park on 8/22.
 - Legislative Priorities A meeting was held recently with representatives from Senator Burr and Senator Tillis' office to review our legislative priorities list with them.
 We will meet again in the fall to update our priorities list.
 - The next LGCCA meeting will be held 7/21/20 at 3:00 pm at the Henderson County Courthouse.

2020 Property Tax Bills Are in the Mail

Town of Fletcher 2020 property tax bills have been mailed. The tax rate remained at \$0.34 per \$100 of property valuation. If you do not receive your tax bill within the next few weeks, please contact us at 828-687-3985. NC General Statute states that failure to receive a tax bill does not negate your obligation to pay your taxes. They are due September 1, 2020, but interest does not begin accruing until January 6, 2021. You may pay your taxes in payments, from August to December, rather than having to pay the entire amount in one lump sum in January. Payments may

be made by cash or check only in the Town Hall. Contactless payments may be placed in our drop box by driving around behind the building (on the right side when facing it) and following the parking lot around the circle. The drop box is on the left side of the drive across from the covered entrance to Town



Hall. You may also pay your taxes by credit or debit card online at <u>https://www.fletchernc.org/departments/</u><u>finance/property-taxes/</u> or also online using your bank's bill pay option which is normally free.

Town of Fletcher 2020-2021 Approved Budget

The Town of Fletcher's budget is supported by four main revenue sources: real estate and personal property taxes (61%), local sales tax (20%), State shared taxes such as utilities, beer/wine, and cable (10%), and Town miscellaneous revenues (4%). More than 84% of residents' tax dollars and other revenue funds are spent on direct services for Town of Fletcher residents:

Document Shred & <u>Pill Drop Event</u>

The Town of Fletcher, in **Sate Secure** conjunction with the Local **Recyclable**



Government Federal Credit Union, will hold a free document shredding event on Saturday, September 12th from 9 am to 12 pm in the southside parking lot at Fletcher Town Hall. We anticipate there will be a limit on the number of boxes each resident can bring for shredding. The Police Department will also host a Pill Drop event to allow for the safe disposal of unused medications. Please leave your old prescriptions in their original bottles. The containers will be emptied by our Officers and then the containers will be given back to you for proper disposal.

Water & sewer billing reminder from Henderson County... You will no longer receive a separate sewer bill from Henderson County since the Metropolitan Sewerage District (MSD) began providing your sewer service on 7/1/20. Sewer charges will be included with your water bill from either the City of Hendersonville or the City of Asheville, depending upon your service location. If you have questions, call Jody Germaine at 828-225-8234.

Have you been contacted by Service Line Warranties? SLWA may have contacted you regarding a protection plan for your water and sewer lines. It is not a scam, this is a legitimate business. The coverage is **voluntary** and operates similar to an insurance policy. The Town is not involved in the administration of this program. For questions about this service, talk with SLWA directly.
