News from the January Town Council Meeting

The meeting was held in the Council Chambers with social distancing guidelines and mass gathering recommendations followed.

- Department Heads presented their preliminary plans for departmental budgets for the upcoming fiscal year 2021/2022 budget.
- By Consent Agenda, the Town Council approved Budget Amendment #2 for the fiscal year 20/21 Budget Ordinance for a 20% match of \$7,280.56 for the sidewalk extension improvements on Howard Gap Road to Highway 25.
- A Public Hearing was held to consider proposed Land Development Code amendments necessary because of the required Chapter 106D statute updates approved by the NC House and Senate. The Town Council approved the amendments as recommended by the Fletcher Planning Board.
- Ben Cathey of McGill & Associates provided an estimate for proposed 2021 Town
 of Fletcher street resurfacing projects. Town Staff has recommended resurfacing
 Golden Oaks Lane, Grove End Road, and Regent Drive during 2021. The preliminary cost estimate by McGill & Associates was \$171,541.50. The final cost will be
 dependent upon the actual project bids which will be determined in February.
- Mark Biberdorf provided an update on project submissions for the FY 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). He plans to present a recommended CIP at the February Town Council Meeting.
- Town Council entered a closed session regarding land negotiation.

Henderson County Changes COVID Vaccination Appointment Process

Henderson Co. Public Health Dept. has launched a COVID-19 vaccine waitlist for adults 65 and older and all health care workers. This will be the new method used to make appointments for the Health Dept.'s vaccine clinics and individuals can sign up at https://www.hendersoncountync.gov/health/page/covid-19-vaccines. The Health Dept. will no longer require individuals to contact the Call Center to make an appointment. The waitlist will follow the priority groups set by the NCDHHS which is those in Group 1 (health care workers, long-term care staff/residents) and Group 2 (adults 65 and older) at this time. Appointments will be made as vaccine becomes available. The waitlist will be organized on a first come, first served basis so the first to sign up will be the first called. Those who enter their e-mail address will receive a confirmation with their number in line. Calls will come from "COVID CC" with the phone number 828-585-4700. The Call Center will make 2 attempts to call individuals when it's their turn. If a person cannot be reached, staff will continue working through the waitlist to make appointments. Those who were unable to be reached will be called the next time appointments are available. Since demand is high, those on the waitlist may not be contacted immediately. Please do not sign up for the waitlist more than once or call the Health Department for a status update. Everyone on the waitlist will be contacted by the Call Center when it's their turn. This waitlist is for 1st dose vaccinations ONLY. Everyone who wants a vaccine will need to register separately. (continued on next page)

NC Continues Modified Stay at Home Order

Governor Cooper issued Executive Order 189 on January 27th extending the "modified stay at home order" until February 28, 2021 at 5:00 pm. During the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am, North Carolinians are still required to stay at home and travel only for work or to obtain essential goods or services. The mass gathering limit still remains at 10 people indoors and 50 people outdoors. Masks are also still required at all times inside public places, for those age 5 and older, and outdoors if 6 foot social distancing cannot be maintained.

Snow Removal

With a little winter weather maybe yet to come, please remember to park your vehicles in your driveway during inclement weather so our trucks can navigate your road safely in order to scrape it.

From our recycling partner, Curbie... "Out with the Bags"

Plastic bags and other film plastic are very difficult for Curbie to handle in our Material Recovery Facility. Please keep plastic bags out of recycling carts and dropoff bins. They clog up our equipment and can cause a lot of wasted time and even equipment damage. At least twice a day, we have to shut the entire sorting facility down and send in people with box cutters to cut the plastic bags out by hand.

If you use bags to collect recycling, we encourage you to please empty the items into the cart, but do not include the bag. Better yet, use a tub, box or bucket to collect recycling and reuse it each week.

Ask these "plastics questions" to discover what plastics can be recycled:

- 1) Is it a container?
- 2) Does it have a number?
- 3) Does it (vaguely) come from a grocery store?

If "yes" to all three questions, then YES it is recyclable.

Remember, ONLY PLASTIC CONTAINERS, such as jugs, tubs, bottles, and jars are recyclable.

- · No plastic shopping bags
- No plastic garbage bags
- No plastic film
- No Ziplock or sandwich bags
- No dry cleaning bags
- No shrink wrap or plastic bubble wrap
- No cereal liner bags or chip bags
- No plastic 6-pack beverage rings
