News from the May 9th Fletcher Town Council Meeting

- Mayor Preston Blakely read a proclamation naming May 2022 as Mental Health Awareness Month in the Town of Fletcher.
- By Consent Agenda, Town Council:
 - Approved property tax releases from the Henderson County Tax Office.
 - Approved a letter supporting Advent Health's proposal to the Division of Health Service Regulation for a new acute care hospital in Buncombe County.
- Jason Seickel, of Equinox Environmental, shared a probable cost estimate for a 1.3 mile westward extension of the Cane Creek Greenway from Bill Moore Community Park to the edge of the Town's property between The Carriage Road and the Meritor Plant on Rockwell Drive. This cost estimate was necessary for additional consideration of this project for Town of Fletcher ARPA funding. Mr. Seickel provided a preferred route cost estimate for a crushed stone path and an estimate for a paved path. The initial projected cost of the least expensive option was \$2.2 million. By consent, Town Council agreed to contact Conserving Carolina about other possible grant funding.
- Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager, provided an update on the development of benchmarking and performance measures for services provided by the Town of Fletcher. He investigated the possibility of the Town participating in a benchmarking project, through the UNC School of Government, in which a list of common municipal services are compared with other municipalities using defined efficiency measures. Our incoming Summer Intern will likely assist in the data gathering process and Mr. Biberdorf will continue with Council updates as progress continues with this project.
- The Fletcher Parks & Recreation Summer Concert Series was held at Blue Ghost Brewery in 2021. For the 2022 summer season, Parks and Rec staff proposed having a concert at Blue Ghost in June and a concert at Bill Moore Community Park in July. After discussion of the proposed change, Town Council agreed with having a concert at both locations this year.

<u>Reminder</u>... Town Hall will be closed May 30th in observance of Memorial Day. No trash or recycling routes will be impacted.

Brush Pickup Reminder

Public Works provides brush pickup for residents who trim their trees themselves with no way to remove the brush. The size of the brush is limited to 6' in length and 6" in diameter and we request that the brush be stacked in a pile along the curbside and not placed in a bag or under power lines, not laying in a ditch, not on top of water meters, or near other objects such as vehicles, phone pedestals, etc. because of the equipment we use (pictured below). Our brush truck has an



extendable arm with a claw that lifts the brush off the ground and into the truck without our employees touching it. So unfortunately if the arm can't reach your brush pile, it does not get picked up as you desired and we had planned. If we have a problem at your location, we try to leave a note explaining the situation, so... "look around if your brush is still on the ground".

Because of the volume of brush we pickup from residents, we started using this brush truck about 4 years ago. As a result, we do not mulch the brush ourselves (except in extreme situations) since we have found it more economical for the Town, and consequently Fletcher residents, for us to haul the collected brush to a third party who grinds it up for mulch. Therefore, your brush pile should be limited to limbs rather than including grass clippings, leaves, vines, weeds, etc.

Please be aware that the brush pickup service we offer, included as part of your annual property taxes, is for residents who have trimmed their own trees. If you hire a professional tree trimmer or landscaper to cut your trees, it is their responsibility to haul off any brush they generate while working on your property.

However if you do have brush that you have trimmed and need it picked up, please make your request on our website at <u>https://www.fletchernc.org/</u> <u>departments/public-works/brush-and-leaves-pick-up/</u>, call 828-654-9208 also 24-hours a day and leave a voice message, or call 828-687-3985 from 8am - 5pm to talk with someone. Requests made this week will be picked up next week unless the request is made before 7:00 am on Monday of the current week. Because you asked...

What is being built behind Bill Moore Community Park?

The property adjacent to the back area of the park, where the greenway ends on the way to the bridge at Mills Gap



Road, belongs to Blue Ridge Metals Corporation. Throughout the years, Blue Ridge Metals has been most kind in allowing our Park users to extend their walks or runs through the Blue Ridge property. However, many of you may have recently noticed a change in that property. Blue Ridge has decided to sell this property, which is zoned for industrial use, and is currently in the process of raising the property elevation through the addition of more soil. Consequently, Park visitors are asked to please observe the barriers to this area and remain off of the Blue Ridge property and out of this construction zone. Thank you for your cooperation.
