#### News from the October 10<sup>th</sup> Fletcher Town Council Meeting

- By Consent Agenda, Town Council approved Sydnee Hammond and Rich Haschke as members of the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board for a 3-year term expiring in October 2025.
- Steve Watkins, Chairman of the Fletcher ABC Board, provided an update on the
  operations at the Fletcher ABC. He shared that they were having issues with their
  new sign, which had been installed earlier this year, and also that he was stepping
  down from the ABC Board.
- Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager, shared a proposal to use a firm called Polco to develop and conduct a citizen survey of Fletcher residents. The proposal was approved and the Town will move forward with the survey.
- The scheduled Public Hearing to discuss an additional extension of the Town Center purchase and sale agreement with developer SDW and JWH, LLC, was not held. Prior to the Council Meeting, the Town received a termination letter from the developer citing a continued inability to reach an agreement with NC DOT regarding traffic design and driveway permit issuance as the reason for their withdrawal from the Town Center project.
- Mark Biberdorf presented the possibility of using the American Rescue Plan (ARP) allocation funds in a manner which eased the administrative and regulatory reporting requirements for the Town. No decision was made on the use of the funds.
- Mark Biberdorf shared the following updates:
  - The Town has received approximately 12 responses from the 38 residents that were contacted about their interest in connecting to sewer if the Town could use ARP funds to assist with some of the installation costs. We will try to contact those residents who have not responded by the October 14th deadline.
  - The Town has learned about a grant program called Reconnecting Communities which provides grant funding through the Federal Infrastructure Bill. The exact details are still unavailable, but it might be a source to provide matching funds for the construction of the Cane Creek/Meritor Greenway trails.
  - The underground wiring has been run to the Hoopers Creek and Wildbriar Road intersection in which an actuated flasher will be installed. The actual equipment installation of the flasher will follow. This flashing light should be an important public safety improvement in this area, especially for the residents of the Cove.

#### November Holiday Closings

#### **Thanksgiving Food Drive**

The Town of Fletcher is still collecting canned food items for the Calvary Food Pantry in Fletcher for distribution to those in need. A large blue collection bin is located on the ground level of Town Hall and also in the lobby to accept



your donations. Our food drive will end November 19th with a drive-thru drop-off event in the Town Hall south side parking lot from 10:30 am - 12:00 noon. Thank you for sharing and caring for your neighbors.

#### Community Meeting - 2023 Real Property Reappraisal

N.C. General Statute §105-286 requires counties to reappraise all real property at least once every eight years with NCGS §105-283 requiring real property to be valued at market value. To promote a fair and equitable tax base, Henderson County conducts a reappraisal of real property every four years. The last reappraisal was conducted in 2019 and the next reappraisal will be effective January 1, 2023.

Darlene Burgess, the Henderson County Tax Administrator, will conduct a meeting on November 29th from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm in the Fletcher Town Hall Multipurpose Room to discuss the upcoming Henderson County real property reappraisal. The community is invited to attend this informational meeting to learn about this required process, the County timetable, and the appeal process.

#### **November NC General Election Voting**

- The last day of One-Stop Early Voting will be Saturday, November 5th from 8:00 am - 3:00 pm. From now until the 5th, Henderson County residents can early vote Monday - Friday from 8:00 am - 7:30 pm at Fletcher Town Hall.
- Election Day is November 8th with voting from 6:30 am to 7:30 pm at your assigned Fletcher precinct (call the Board of Elections if you are not sure of your precinct).
- For a sample ballot, go to the NC State Board of Elections Voter Search website at https://vt.ncsbe.gov/ RegLkup/. Enter the requested information and click "Search". Then select your name from the search results at the top of the page and scroll down the page to the "Your Sample Ballot" section. Click on the blue hyperlink under "Your Sample Ballot" to see your specific ballot.
- Any questions regarding absentee voting, early voting, your assigned voting precinct, or the upcoming election should be addressed to the Henderson County Board of Elections at 828-697-4970 or you can visit their website at https://www.hendersoncountync.gov/elections.

#### Planning Board/Zoning Board of Adjustment Vacancy - At-Large Seat

The Town of Fletcher is seeking to fill a vacancy on the Planning Board & Zoning Board of Adjustment. (Members serve dual roles on the one Board.) Functions of the Planning Board include recommendations to the Town Council on applications related to Rezoning, Conditional Rezoning, Special Use Permits, and text amendments to the Town's Land Development Code. The Board also reviews preliminary plats for major subdivisions as well as design review for projects in the "Heart of Fletcher" Overlay. Functions of the ZBA include quasi-judicial hearings regarding applications for variances and appeals on zoning matters.

An "At-Large" seat may be filled by anyone who resides in the Town limits, and is not specific to a particular Council district. The Board typically meets once per month, on the 3rd Tuesday at 6:00 p.m. Anyone interested in applying may access the application at this link: <a href="https://www.fletchernc.org/town-government/town-committees/board-openings/">https://www.fletchernc.org/town-government/town-committees/board-openings/</a> OR by contacting either the Town Clerk or Planning Director at (828) 687-3985. Previous applicants from earlier this year will be considered, and additional applications will be accepted through November 30, 2022. The Town Council is responsible for appointments to all volunteer Boards. Applicants will need to be available to attend a Council meeting as part of the process if requested (most likely in December or January).

#### Fletcher ABC Board Chair Vacancy

The Town of Fletcher is seeking to fill the Board Chair vacancy on the Fletcher ABC Board. This board is appointed by the Town Council and is responsible for running the A.B.C. Store and hiring the employees who work in the store. This board is separate from the other boards in the Town in that it handles its own affairs and also has an independent audit.

All interested applicants must be a resident of the Town of Fletcher and be willing to serve a three-year term.

The chairman of the Fletcher ABC Board responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Be familiar with ABC law and operate within the boundaries of the laws and rules that apply to alcohol in our community and the state.
- Oversee the personnel of the local ABC Board by being available with insight and advice on most store repairs that require the disbursement of a large sum of money.
- Ensure that public confidence and trust in the ABC system are preserved.
- Hold the employees of the board to the highest standard of reporting and disbursement of public monies.
- Borrow money for the board as provided in NC General Statute § B-702.
- Promote a customer-friendly, modern, and efficient store.
- Be available at least once per month, and sometimes more, for a meeting that is held to make decisions regarding personnel, operations, and other matters.
- The Board typically meets once per month.
