News from the December 8th Town Council Meeting

- By Consent Agenda, Town Council:
 - Approved property tax releases from the Henderson County Tax Office.
 - Approved January 12, 2026, as a Public Hearing for a Conditional Zoning
 District application request to rezone 28 Cane Creek Road from R-2 Medium
 Density Residential District to Neighborhood Business District Conditional
 Zoning District to allow for the development of a bakery/restaurant by Fletcher
 Village Bakery in the Heart of Fletcher Overlay District.
 - Approved Resolution R-25-11 to donate the Fletcher Police Department's surplus 2018 Harley Davidson motorcycle to the Henderson County Sheriff's Office.
 - Approved revisions to the Fletcher Stormwater Off-of-Right-of-Way Grant Program to include the following language in the Approval Process: "The onsite evaluation may include a requirement to hire an engineer to design any potential improvements."
- Multiple applications were received for consideration to fill the two at-large vacancies on the Fletcher Planning Board. Jacob Compher and Julia Fogel were appointed to fill the vacant seats.
- Representatives from the Fletcher Youth Baseball and Softball Program shared information regarding their organization as well as results from a fall survey of their league participants. There was a discussion of some of their growing pain challenges at Bill Moore Community Park such as parking, field lighting, concessions, scoreboards, and Saturday morning field maintenance. During the 2025 Spring season they had 387 players with 85 of those households located within the Fletcher town limits.
- Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager, shared a proposed timeline for preparation of the fiscal year 2026-2027 budget:
 - January 12th at 4:00 pm During the Town Council Regular Meeting, department heads will make brief presentations of 2025-2026 accomplishments and provide a big picture of significant needs for the upcoming year.
 - March 24th at 8:30 am Special Called Meeting for the presentation of 2026-2027 departmental budget requests to Town Council.
 - May 7th at 9:00 am Budget workshop/retreat for the Town Manager's presentation of the recommended 2026-2027 budget to Town Council.
 - June 8th Public hearing on the recommended budget and possible adoption of the 2026-2027 budget.
- Town Council then went into a Closed Session regarding personnel matters.

2025 Property Taxes Due January 5th

2025 property taxes are due on or before January 5, 2026, to avoid 2% interest which will be applied to all unpaid balances on January 6th. Mailed payments must display a USPS postmark prior to 1/6/26 to avoid interest. You may also pay your taxes online at www.fletchernc.org/departments/finance/property-taxes/; in person at Fletcher Town Hall via cash, check or money order; or place your payment in our southside parking lot drop box 24 hours a day.

Enforced collection action on any unpaid 2025 taxes may begin January 6th.

Personal Property Tax Listings Due 1/31/26

N.C. General Statute §105-308 provides that anyone who owns property on January 1st which is subject to taxation must list that property with their County Assessors Office no later than January 31st. Failure to do so will result in a 10% penalty by the County and the Town of Fletcher and back taxes if the property is ultimately discovered by the Henderson Co. Assessor.

Types of property that should be listed include:

<u>Personal Property</u> including mobile homes; unregistered (untagged) motor vehicles; motorcycles; RV's; campers; travel trailers; utility trailers; boats; personal watercraft; and aircraft.

<u>Business personal property</u> including property used in the production of income or in connection with any business enterprise including machinery & equipment, furniture & fixtures, computers, supplies and expensed Items used in a Sole Proprietorship, Partnership or Corporation, regardless of whether the business has its own address or is a Home-Based business.

Real property, if buildings or other Improvements with a value over \$100 were acquired, built, erected, damaged or destroyed since January 1, 2025.

Property Listing forms may be obtained on the County website at https://hendersoncountync.gov/tax by selecting "Forms and Applications" along the left side of the page. Business property tax listings may also be submitted online at https://bpp.taxscribe.app/nc and individual personal property listings may be submitted online at https://ipp.taxscribe.app/nc.

Property Tax Relief Assistance

Several taxpayers have asked about the availability of property tax relief programs for elderly or disabled residents. The applications for 2026 taxes must be filed with the Henderson County Tax Assessor's Office by June 1, 2026. 
We Need Your Help Filling a Planning Board/Zoning Board Fletcher ETJ Vacancy

The Town of Fletcher is seeking to fill a vacancy on the Planning Board & Zoning Board of Adjustment for the Extra-Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) of Fletcher. Applications/applicants will first be reviewed by Town Council, and a recommendation will be made to the County Commissioners, who will appoint the recommended individual. Anyone living in the ETJ of Fletcher and is interested in applying for this vacancy may access the application at https://www.fletchernc.org/town-government/town-committees/board-openings/ or by contacting the Town Clerk,

Christine Thompson, or the Planning Director, Tyler Morrow, at 828-687-3985. You may also contact Tyler, if you are unsure if you live in the ETJ, or are unable to tell from the map shown here. The green hatched area shows the approximate extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Functions of the Planning Board include recommendations to the Town Council on applications related to Rezoning, Conditional Rezoning, Special Use Permits, and text amendments to the Town's Land Development Code. The Board also reviews preliminary plats for major subdivisions and design review for projects in the "Heart of Fletcher" overlay. Functions of the ZBA include quasi-judicial hearings regarding applications for variances and appeals on zoning matters.

The Board typically meets once per month, on the 3rd Tuesday at 6:00 pm. The application period will remain open until the vacancy is filled.




